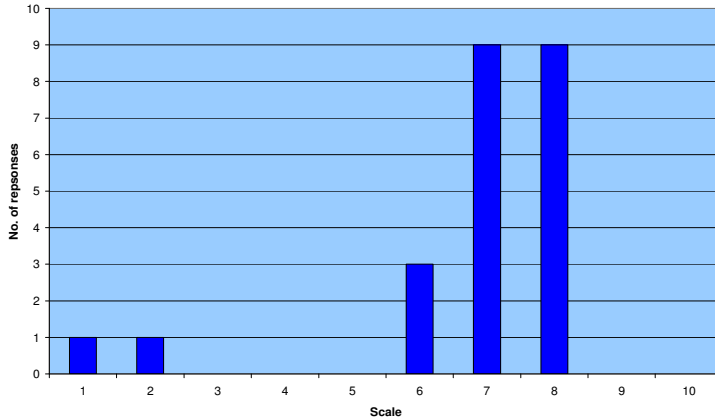

23 of a possible 35 evaluation form were returned

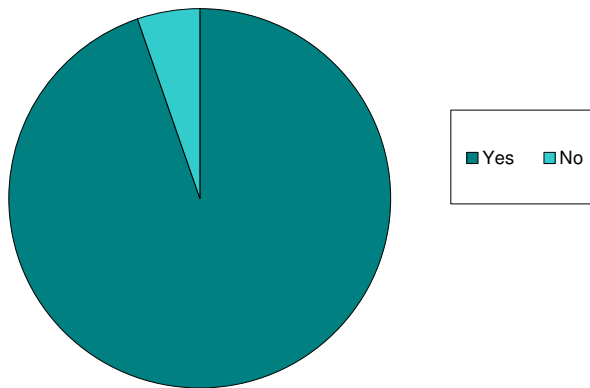
1. Please tell us in what ways you use the river?

2. How useful have you found the workshop? (1 = not useful, 10 = extremely useful)



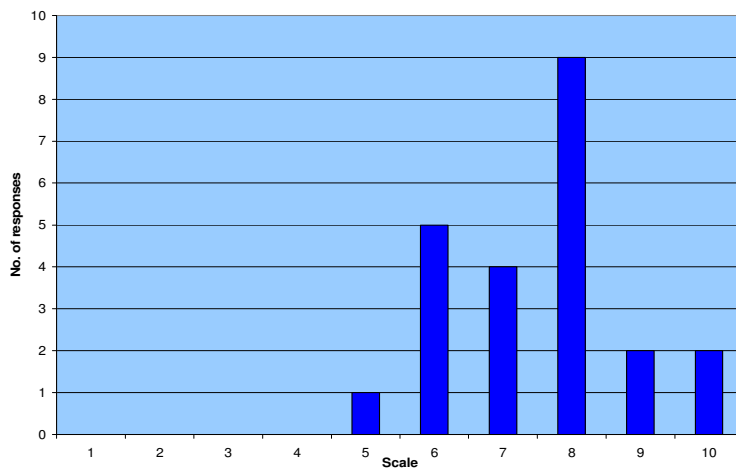
3. Do you feel that the objectives you gave at the beginning of the day were met?



4. If No how could we have met your objectives?

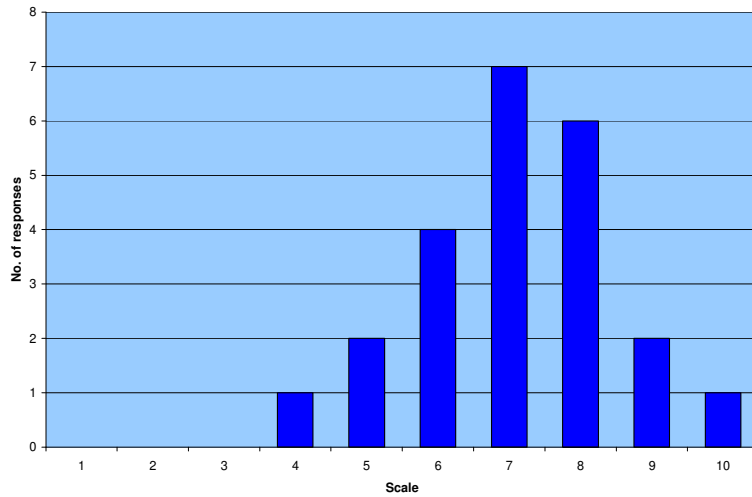
- More focus on local issues

(1 = not at all, 10 = answered fully)

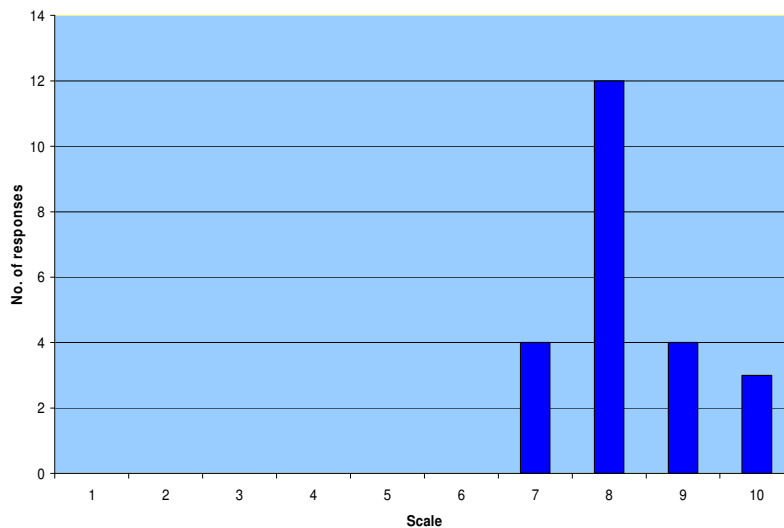

(1 = unable to give views, 10 = fully able to give views)

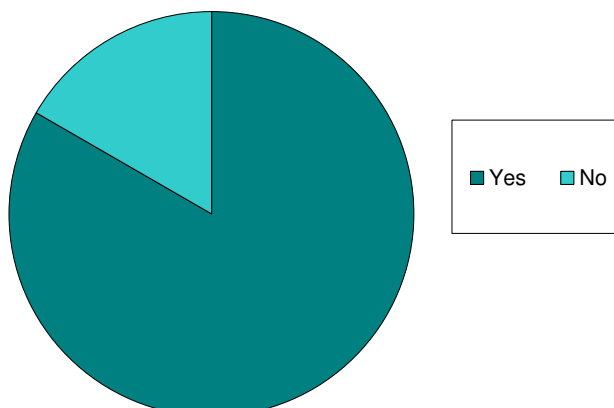

9. Were you happy with the venue for the event?



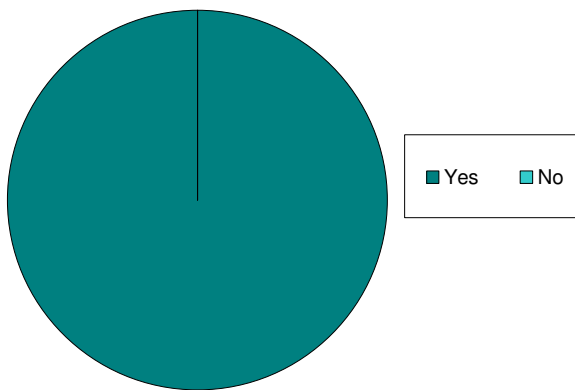
10. Please tell us if there is anything we could have done to improve the venue or facilities?
